The William B. McHenry Scholarship Program is sponsored by the Michigan Propane Gas Association (MPGA) for MPGA members, their employees and their families who are attending or planning to attend any community college, university or school of higher learning. Each year, the MPGA awards two scholarships for up to \$2,500 in honor of William B. McHenry, whose passion and untiring energy advanced safety and training programs for the propane industry. If you are interested in applying for this scholarship, please complete the application in full and return it to the address on the form. The MPGA is pleased to offer this opportunity for you.

STANDARDS

The following standards will apply to all MPGA Scholarship funds applicants:

- Applicants must be at least a half-time student
- Applicants may reapply after 15 months if not awarded a scholarship during that period
- Applicants must be a **dependent child** of an employee of a member of the Michigan Propane Gas Association. The parent's work must be directly related to the propane industry. The MPGA member must be in good standing with the Michigan Propane Gas Association.
- Applicants must be full time residents of the State of Michigan.
- Applicants must show proof of enrollment prior to being awarded a scholarship.

- Upon notification of winning a scholarship, applicants must submit a photo of themselves and a biography for submission in our quarterly magazine, the *Michigan Propane Journal*.
- The Committee will present scholarship awards at the 2022 Great Lakes Propane Convention in Grand Rapids, Michigan. The recipient will also receive a one room/night complimentary accommodations (if needed) and dinner for him/herself and two guests. **Award winners' attendance is mandatory at the banquet that will be held the evening of July 27, 2022.**
- **Application deadline is March 25, 2022.** Application must be **RECEIVED** in the MPGA office by this date.
- The MPGA Scholarship Committee strives to assist as many young scholars as possible. **Past scholarship recipients are not eligible to receive the award again.**
